2. Name three people (living or dead, real or imaginary) you admire most. Why do you feel this way about these people?
3. What is the best book, play, or poem you have ever read? Why did you like it so much?
4. Tell us about your earliest acting experience and what it meant to you.
5. If you could invent a new food, what would it be?
6. Describe a place where you like to be and why.
7. What really makes you happy? Why?
8. What really makes you angry? Why?
9. What are the most important things in the world to you?
10. Do you have something you have written (a poem or part of a story) that you can contribute to this application?

• On a separate sheet of paper, list your previous training, classes, and workshops in theater, dance, television, modeling, sports, etc.

Applications will be considered in the order they are received and all applications will be kept confidential. All applicants will be interviewed. Please include a headshot/snapshot.
